### Preschool

68 Broad Street is home to our Community Center Preschool licensed and operated by the Borough of Eatontown. Programs are available to children ages 2 1/2 and up. Our staff is certified and our center licensed by NJ Division of Children & Family Services.

### Before-After School Care Program

We offer before and after school age care to our Eatontown resident public school students Kindergarten - 6th grade, September - June following the Eatontown Public School calendar.

### Summer Preschool Prep Half Day

Our six week half day summer program offers 2 1/2 - 3 1/2 year old children a unique summer camp experience. We offer indoor and outdoor learning opportunities and social activities in a small group setting. Registration available until slots are full, space is limited.

### Full Day 6 Week Summer Camp

We offer a full day six- week program to Eatontown resident students entering grades 1 - 4 in September. The program offers a variety of indoor and outdoor activities as well as weekly offsite trips. Space is limited.

## Eatontown Library

Our community library, 33 Broad Street offers a wide variety of materials and programs to our residents. The library building's 5000 square feet, offer a sitting area, large variety of newspapers and magazines, music, books, DVD's and children's materials, collections are expansive and updated frequently. Eatontown is a member of the Monmouth County Library system, on-site desktop computers available for public use. Each Wednesday children's programs are available. Some programs require pre-registration and fill quickly, contact the library directly for further information and schedule.

## Eatontown Youth Recreation Programs

### **Recreation Basketball Clinic** - A six week, Saturday morning program.

Children ages 4 - 6 years old, grades Pre-K and Kindergarten are welcome to join us and experience the sport of basketball. Skills and drills introduced and practiced each week. Payers must supply a basketball. Clinic runs Mid-January - end of February each year. Registration is available throughout the year ending two weeks before clinic start date. Price: 1 Player \$60.- 2 or more players same family \$80.

**1st - 8th Grade Basketball League** - Teams chosen and practices begin in December. 7 games are played. There are no playoffs. Games begin in January and end in early March. 1st and 2nd grade play together this division co-ed. Boys Divisions organized as follows: 3rd & 4th Grade, 5th & 6th Grade, 7th & 8th Grade. Girls Divisions 3rd - 5th grade and 6th - 8th grade. Teams meet twice a week, one night is practice and one night is game night. Girl's divisions may run as a clinic depending on number of registered players. Registration available throughout the year and ends in November. Price: 1 player \$75. - 2 or more players same family \$105.

**Recreation Soccer Clinics** - Soccer clinics take place in the spring and in the fall. Clinics are six weeks. Players ages 3 years through 2nd grade are eligible to participate and are grouped by age and grade. Registration available all year, ends two weeks prior to start of clinic. Players must supply a soccer ball. Price: \$60. One player 2 or more same family \$80.

**3rd - 8th Grade Fall Soccer League** - Open to players grades 3rd - 8th. Girls Divisions are organized by grade as follows: 3rd & 4th Girls, 5th & 6th Girls, 7th & 8th Girls. Boys Divisions are organized as follows: 3rd & 4th Boys, 5th & 6th Boys, 7th & 8th Boys. We participate in the Northern Monmouth Soccer League. One game and practice each week. Practices begin in Mid-August and games begin the Saturday after Labor Day, there is one home game each week in Eatontown or in our neighborhood communities of Tinton Falls, West Long Branch, Shrewsbury, Fair Haven, Monmouth Beach. Registration closes June 28. Volunteer coaches needed. Price: \$75.00 one player - 2 or more players same family \$105.00

**Recreation Softball for Girls** - Softball offered in the spring, registration in January and February. We play jointly with Tinton Falls and registration is done online only, go to <http://tintonfallslittleleague.com/news/id/32273> Open to girls ages 7 to 15. 7-8 years \$125. Per player 9 -12 years \$145. Per player- 13 - 15 years \$160. Per player

## Eatontown Youth Recreation Programs Continued

**Recreation Summer Camp** - A six week, half day program, 9 AM - 12PM, location Wolcott Park, camp begins the Monday following 4th of July and ends Mid-August. Open to campers ages 4 (must be 4 by June 1 of the current calendar year). Camp is outdoors, schedule of activities includes a variety of outdoor sports and games. Our staff of high school and college students leads campers through the camp morning. Activities rotate every thirty minutes. Campers grouped by the grade they will enter the upcoming school year. Beginning week two of camp an off-site trip is available at an additional fee each week. Contact our recreation office to obtain information and to register. Registration closes end of June. Price \$190. first child \$140. Additional children same family

**Summer CIP Program** - Summer Camp Counselor in training program available to Eatontown students entering grades 8 and 9 in September of the next school year. Application deadline for this program is May 15 each year. Not all applicants are accepted. If a student entering 8th grade is not accepted into CIP program they may register for summer camp program as a camper and camp registration fee applies. Students entering 9th grade are not age eligible for our summer camp program. Price \$30. Per CIP

**Eatontown Youth Committee** - Eatontown students 7th - 12th grade invited to join our student community service group. EYC meets the first Wednesday of each month October - June. October meeting dedicated to choosing and organizing our community service project calendar. Students execute one community service project each month. Each year the students generate many interesting ideas. FREE

## RECREATION PROGRAMS- HOW TO REGISTER

1. **Online Registration-** go to [www.eatontownnj.com](http://www.eatontownnj.com) and choose Recreation from Borough Departments listed along top of the page. On the recreation home page click on the orange line halfway down that says "Program Registration now available online", or go directly to <https://register.capturepoint.com/eatontown> If you have previously registered for programs, a family account is already set up for you. If you do not know your username and password call our office 732-389-7607 for assistance. First time registrants follow the steps below to create an account.

1. Go to [www.eatontownnj.com](http://www.eatontownnj.com) and click on the Recreation Department from the top menu bar. On the recreation department main screen scroll down to the line in orange letters- click on- "Program registration now available on line" Follow instructions to create an account or skip to step 2 if you have an account.

2. Log in with your user name and password, select "Browse Activities" and choose the appropriate activity.

3. Verify that your account information is up to date and accurate, pay close attention to telephone numbers, emergency contact information, shirt sizes. Verify your email address.

4. Select participants: add additional family members here. Select the members you wish to register to view programs that person is eligible to enroll in.

5. Select from the list of age/grade appropriate programs displayed for each family member. Click on the activities and view "details" to the right of the program name.

6. Complete the registration for each participant. Review your information and pay using your credit card. A confirmation email goes to your email address.

**In Person or by Mail Registration:** Complete the registration form on the next page.

1. Place completed form in mail with check payment to 47 Broad St. Eatontown NJ 07724. Attention: Recreation

2. In person registration: complete the registration form, bring to the Recreation office. Our office hours are Monday - Friday 8:30AM - 4:30PM. Contact us to be sure someone is in the office.

3. All program registration accepted on a first come, first serve basis. In order to reserve your spot we suggest you register online as early as possible as many of our programs cap at a maximum number of participants.
