APPLYING FOR A MARRIAGE LICENSE

REQUIRED DOCUMENTS: to be presented when applying for a marriage license:

- 1. **Proof of Identity** Photo ID present your driver's license, passport or state/federal I.D.
- 2. Proof of Residency only if New Jersey Resident
- 3. Your social security number +
- **4. A witness –** 18 years of age or older, your witness will need provide identification
- **5. \$28.00 application fee –** cash, money order or check payable to "Borough of Eatontown"

NOTE: You must apply for your marriage license in the town that you or your fiancé reside

+Any Social Security Number is required by law for US citizens and will be kept confidential. Any documents in a foreign language must be accompanied by a certified English translation.

Please know in which town and on which date your marriage ceremony will occur **before** you apply for a marriage license.

REQUESTED ADDITIONAL DOCUMENTS: these documents are helpful but **not** required:

- **1. Birth Certificate** a copy will establish your parents' names and related birth information
- **2. Divorce Decrees and Annulment Documents** please bring final divorce decree or annulment document or termination for a prior marriage, prior civil union or prior domestic partnership
- 3. Death Certificate if former spouse/civil union or domestic partner is deceased

After you apply:

1. **72 hour Waiting Period** – 72 hours <u>must</u> elapse between license application and issuance. The Waiting period begins when the application is <u>FILED</u> with the LOCAL Registrar *NOTE* There is no 72 hour waiting period for a <u>remarriage</u>; however you must bring a <u>certified copy</u> of the <u>existing</u> marriage

- **2. Marriage Application** application for license is valid for <u>6 months</u> from date of application *NOTE* Only ONE marriage license may be granted from a marriage application
- **3. License Issuance –** once a license is issued to the couple it is valid for **THIRTY DAYS**
- **4. License Expiration –** if a license expires **before** use, a **new application** must be made repeating all steps
