Wednesday, March 1 at 4:00 pm

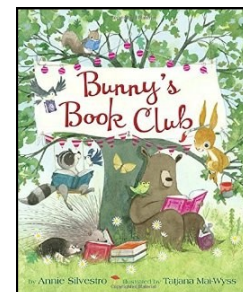
Come meet a local hockey team from Middletown!

and learn the facts versus fiction about these reptiles.

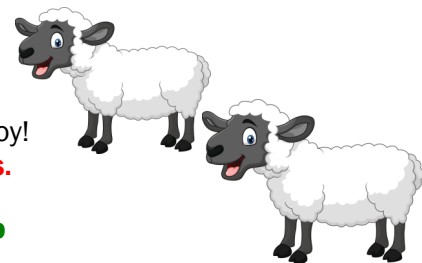


PUNK FARM - Grades K and Up
