ORDINANCE AMENDING THE TAX COLLECTOR’S SALARY FOR THE YEARS 2022-2023

WHEREAS, the Borough Council adopted the Salary Ordinance 33-2019 setting the salary ranges for Borough employees and officials for the years 2020 through 2023; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Administrator advised the Council that given the tight constraints of the labor market, he needs flexibility in order to fill the Tax Collector’s position, either full time or part-time and the salary range for the position needs to be modified accordingly.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Eatontown that it hereby amends Salary Ordinance 33-2019 for the position of Tax Collector for the years 2022-2023 and the annual salary and compensation of the Tax Collector for the Borough of Eatontown be, and the same are hereby fixed as set forth as follows:
