### **ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH DELETING CHAPTER 342 OF THE BOROUGH CODE ENTITLED “PLUMBING”**

**WHEREAS**, the Construction Official and the Director of Land Use recommends deleting Chapter 342 of the Borough Code entitled “Plumbing” in its entirety because it is outdated and now governed by state law and other sections of the Borough Code; and

**WHEREAS**, the Borough Council believes it is in the best interest of the Borough to implement the recommendations of the Construction Official to ensure the Borough Code is up to date and in compliance with state law.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Borough Council of the Borough of Eatontown, County of Monmouth, State of New Jersey that the Borough Council hereby deletes Chapter 342, Sections 342-1 through 342-6 in their entirety.

**IT IS FURTHER ORDAINED**, that if any section, paragraph, subsection, clause, or provision of this Ordinance shall be adjudged by the courts to be invalid, such adjudication shall apply only to the section, paragraph, subsection, clause, or provision so adjudged, and the remainder of this Ordinance shall be deemed valid and effective.

**IT IS FURTHER ORDAINED** that any ordinances or parts thereof in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are repealed to the extent of such conflict.

**IT IS FURTHER ORDAINED** that this Ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication in accordance with applicable law.
